<u>Subject</u>: CMA CGM Vasco de Gama delayed out of Singapore

On 12 November 2018, while port side alongside at Yangshan terminal, **CMA CGM Vasco de Gama** has suffered a grounding.

Diving inspections were lead shortly after and crack was discovered on rudder.

Repair of rudder has been carried out and vessel sailed out of Singapore on 26th of November 8 days behind the initial schedule.

No damaged was caused to the cargo loaded on board of CMA CGM Vasco de Gama and no containers were discharged from the vessel.

CMA CGM operations teams are working on a comprehensive contingency plan. We will communicate the revised ETA in North Europe in the best possible delay.
