

Safmarine Customer Advisory - Prohibited Cargo to Saudi Arabia

Dear valued customer,

Following an enforcement by Saudi customs, we are sharing a reminder of the regulation for the **IN-TRANSIT** cargo in the kingdom of Saudi Arabia.

Kindly note that as per Saudi customs regulations, while prohibited cargo (indicated list provided below) is not allowed for import/transhipment containers however for IN TRANSIT, the prohibited cargo has to be declared prior vessel arrival at any Saudi Arabian port.

Prohibited cargo:

- Alcohol.
- Spirits.
- Wine beverages with alcohol.
- Drugs & Narcotics.
- Pork meat.
- Pork products.
- Pornographic articles.
- Religious and political literature.

To generate the on-board reports on timely manner, please indicate the exact commodity HS CODE (minimum last 4 digits) at booking stage to avoid any implications from the Saudi customs authority
