Service Update: ACSA3 - Change of Port Call in Chile

Dear Valued Customer,

To improve the operational efficiency on our ACSA3 service, the port of call in Chile will shift from San Antonio to Valparaiso. Please see below the timeline and specific details, including two transitional sailings that will exceptionally call San Antonio during the change.

Effective Date for Port Change:

- Voyage: OLSJ3E1MA Ever Legacy (Current vessel name)
- ETD Hong Kong (HKHKG): November 18, 2024.
- ETA Valparaiso (CLVAP): January 6, 2025.

Transitional Period Details:

During this transition, two COSCO-operated vessels will continue calling San Antonio, CL:

- 1st Voyage: OLSJ7E1MA Xin Los Angeles (Current vessel name)
- ETD Hong Kong (HKHKG): December 2, 2024
- ETA San Antonio (CLSAI): January 20, 2025
- 2nd Voyage: OLSJHE1MA Cosco Pacific (Current vessel name)
- ETD Hong Kong (HKHKG): January 6, 2025
- ETA San Antonio (CLSAI): February 24, 2025

Permanent Shift for Entire ACSA3 Fleet:

Starting with the following sailing, the entire ACSA3 fleet will shift exclusively and permanently calling Valparaiso (CLVAP) and will no longer call San Antonio (CLSAI).

- Voyage: OLSJJE1MA Ever Lyric (Current vessel name)
- ETD Hongkong (HKHKG): January 13, 2025
- ETA Valparaiso (CLVAP): March 3, 2025.

All other service specifications will remain unchanged.
