As you may be aware, under the Network of the Future, our mainliner services are designed to be 'leaner', with half the average amount of port calls per service rotation, compared to today. This means the average number of stops a container will make between the origin and final destination will decrease significantly.

These mainliner services will be complemented by an extensive network of intra-regional shuttles. Our intraregional shuttles will connect hub terminals to strategic gateways, from which mainliners depart, and will mostly have 2 port calls per service, aiming to give more reliability to logistics moves.
