## **Changes to Asia to US East Coast and US Gulf Network**

Dear ZIM Customer,

Due to recent changes in trade between China and the United States, and the resulting shift in market demand, we are adjusting our service for Asia to US East Coast and US Gulf. These changes are subject to regulatory approval.

**ZIM Container Service Pacific (ZCP)** – Pusan – Yantian – Xiamen – Ningbo – Shanghai – Pusan – Manzanillo, Mexico – Panama Canal – Kingston, Jamaica – New York – Baltimore – Savannah – Charleston – Kingston, Jamaica – Panama Canal – Pusan

First effective vessel: ZIM Mount Rainier ETA Yantian 12th May

**ZIM Xpress Boston (ZXB)** – Singapore – Cai Mep – Haiphong – Yantian – Kaohsiung – Panama Canal – Cartagena – Charleston – Savannah – Norfolk – New York Maher – Boston – Cape of Good Hope – Singapore

First effective vessel: ZIM Spinel ETA Singapore 11th May

**ZIM Seven Stars (Z7S)** – Laem Chabang – Haiphong – Cai Mep – Singapore – Cape of Good Hope – New York – Baltimore – Savannah – Jacksonville – Cape of Good Hope – Singapore – Laem Chabang

First effective vessel: MSC Douala VIII ETA Laem Chabang 8th May

**ZIM South Lotus (ZSL)** – Cai Mep – Yantian – Ningbo – Shanghai – Pusan – Panama Canal – Mobile – Houston – Tampa – Miami – Cape of Good Hope – Singapore – Cai Mep

First effective vessel: MSC Maputo ETA Yantian 15th May

ZIM North Star (ZNS) and ZIM Gulf Central China Express (ZGC) services will be temporarily suspended. The final ZNS sailing will be MSC Texas, with an estimated time of arrival in Qingdao on April 26th. The ZGC service will be suspended following the departure of MSC Long Beach VI, which is expected to arrive in Ningbo on May 9<sup>th</sup>
